Entry money will not be refunded once the entry has been made.

Hats must be to the minimum standard, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015; 1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572; 2005, or SEI American Standard SNELL E2001, ASTM 95, SNZ3838; 1998. Skull Cap hats must be worn with a silk.

Any complaint must be lodged at the Secretary's caravan with the payment of £5, which will be forfeited should the objection not be sustained.

The decision of the judges shall be final.

No entries taken once the class has commenced.

The committee reserve the right to refuse an entry.

Any competitor not ready when called may be eliminated.

Any rider on leading rein must remain on it whilst on the show ground.
